Onondaga Earth Corps Overview

The Onondaga Earth Corps (OEC) is a locally based youth development and employment program focusing on community and environmental stewardship in Syracuse, NY. OEC hires young adults, ages 15 to 25, to educate the community about the benefits of environmental stewardship through completing environmental and neighborhood improvement projects in the City of Syracuse. OEC has a strong experiential learning and service component, and life skills are learned via formal lessons, on-the-job training, and through the Corps experience.

Position Overview

The youth crew often works on a variety of projects, from public outreach and education development, to neighborhood demonstration projects and tree planting programs. The work is based on environmental science and community development, and participants will be provided with basic training in these areas. Public presentation and creating materials, such as PowerPoints, videos, brochures, etc., are often requirements of the work as well as working outside in gardens and landscaping settings.

The schedule will vary from Spring to Summer to Fall. It is likely that Saturdays and Sundays will be regularly scheduled, with some after school sessions possible. Estimated hours are 12-18 a week, with the potential to increase weekly hours. Please direct questions to acanino@onondagaeearthcorps.org.

The Youth Crew's primary responsibilities in Spring 2016 are to engage the community in tree planting and plant up to 75 trees in the neighborhood, as well as maintain residential landscapes and commit to training sessions schedule ahead of time.

Crewmembers Duties and Responsibilities

- Maintain a professional and respectful demeanor at all times.
- Actively participate in training focused on the professional and technical skills of both OEC's tree planting and green infrastructure program, which includes community outreach, environmental education and leadership.
- Participate in day-to-day details of crew, flexibility when plans are changing.

- Ability to work effectively as a team member, and work well with other corps members, staff, the public and OEC partners.

- Willingness and ability to work outdoors in a physical job that will include walking, lifting, bending, and teamwork.
- High School diploma, GED, or proof of working towards such.
- Sense of humor, spirit of adventure and desire to make a positive difference in our community.
